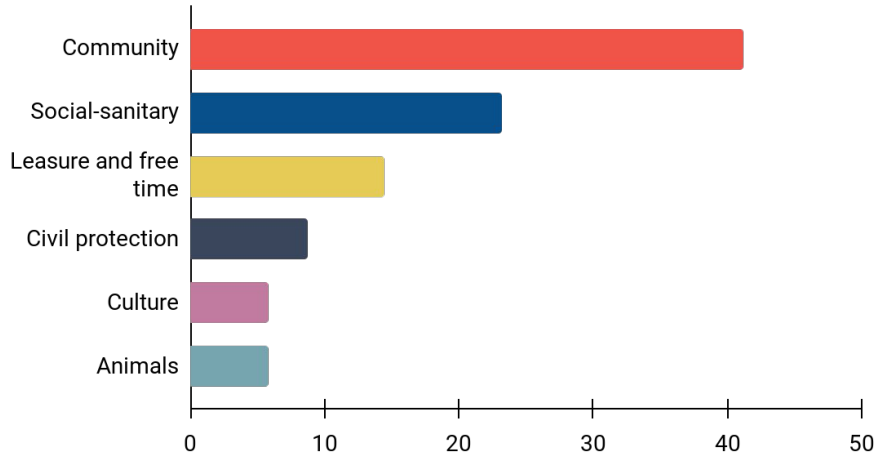

Social-sanitary volunteering

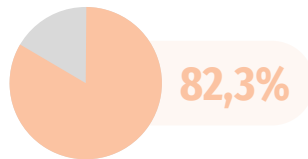

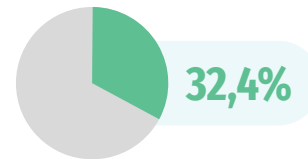

The most popular projects in Spain:



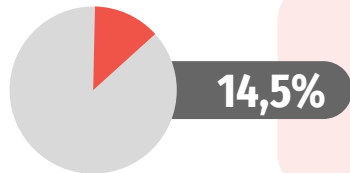
Social exclusion

Promote integration of migrant people. Contribute to the improvement of life quality of disabled people

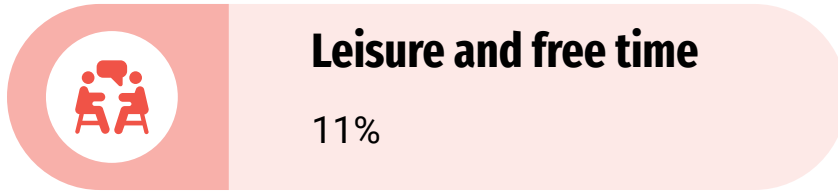
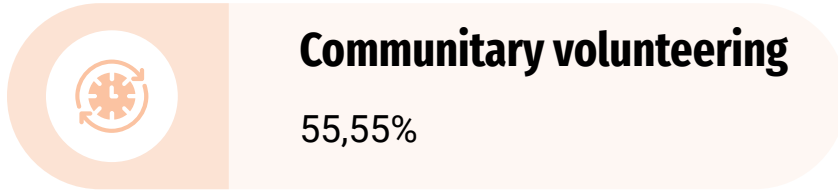


Old people and food collection

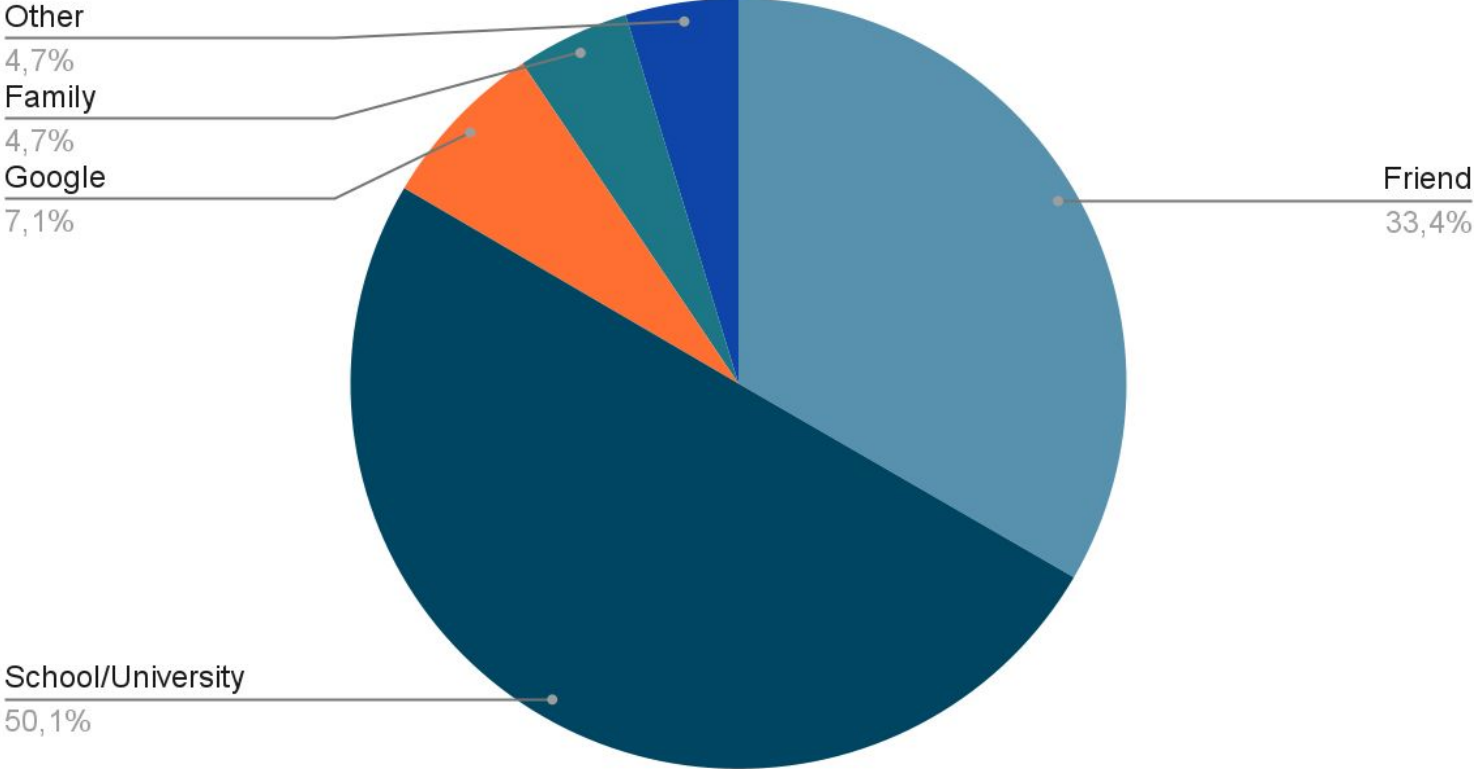
Accompany old people and contribute to their life quality. Collect food for needed people

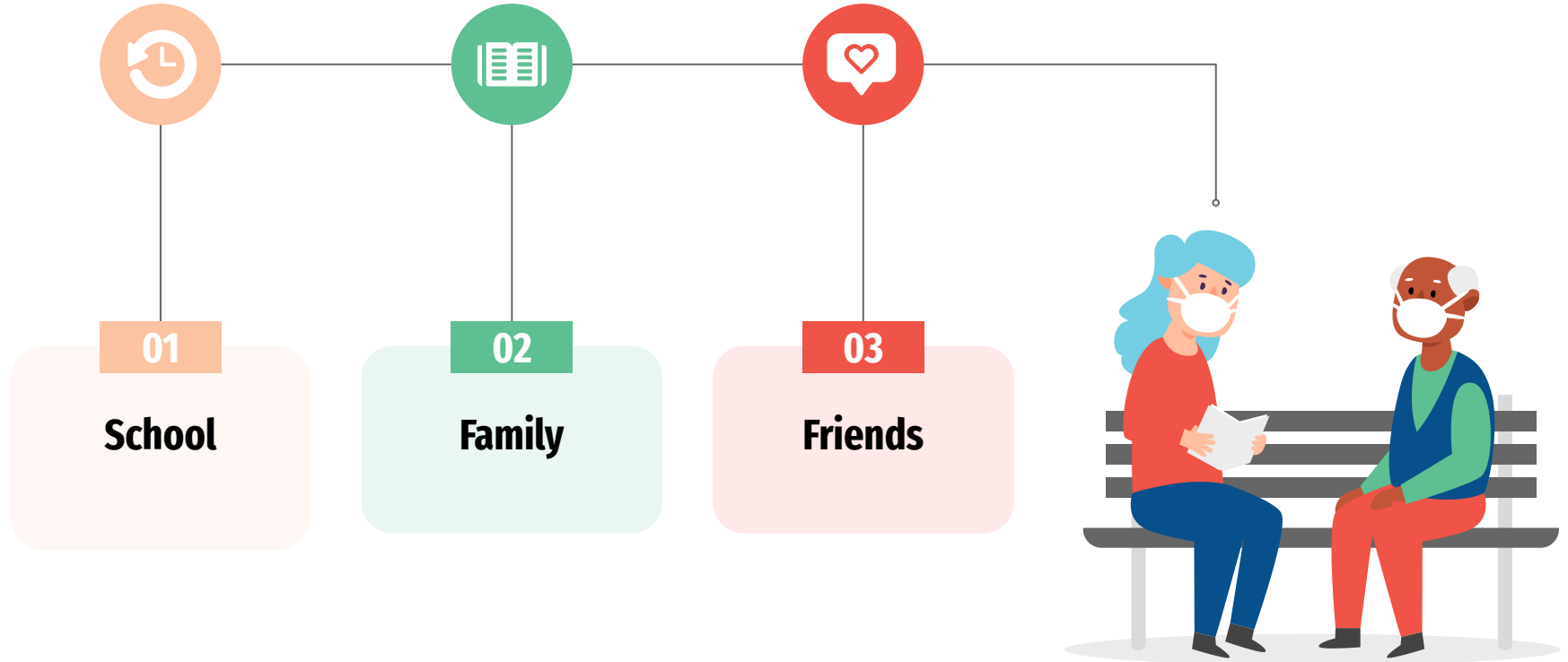

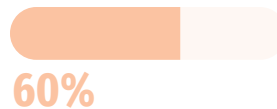

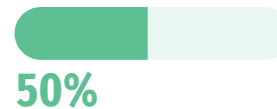

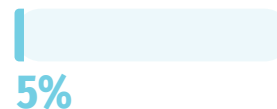
